[N THE BEGINNING THERE WAS NO DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE WORKING COWBOY AND THE RODEO COWBOY, AND IN FACT, THE TERM WORK-ING COWBOY DID NOT COME INTO USE UNTIL THE 1950S. PRIOR TO THAT IT WAS ASSUMED THAT ALL COWBOYS WERE WORKING COWBOYS. EARLY COWBOYS BOTH WORKED ON RANCHES AND DISPLAYED THEIR SKILLS AT THE ROUND-UPS. The advent of professional rodeos aligwed cowboys, like many athletes, to earn a living by performing their skills before an audience.
